Kitchen Corner

Easy Peanut Butter Fudge (no boiling!)

Ingredients:

- 18 oz unsalted butter
- 1 cup creamy peanut butter
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 1 LB powdered sugar

Before starting, line an 8" x 8" pan with parchment

Combine the butter and peanut butter in a large microwave safe bowl. Microwave for 1 minute and stir, repeat. If mixture is completely melted and smooth, move on, if not work in 30 second increments until melty smooth.

Add vanilla, stir.

Add all the powdered sugar and work in until a smooth batter forms. It will be quick thick.

Spread fudge into prepared pan. Refrigerate 2 hours or more. Cut into small squares and enjoy the deliciousness within a week.
